



## **RACING REPORT AND RESULTS - 2005**

At last year's AGM we made a commitment to be more communicative about our racing activities this year. We placed an advert in the District Council Handbook and I produced the first two editions of the KCA Newsletter each of which enjoyed a mainly e-mail circulation in excess of 200. This new approach appears to have paid off handsomely. Whilst the DC has suffered a 25% reduction in entries overall in Kent, I am happy to announce that every single one of our events showed an increase in entries over 2004.

It was evident from very early in the season that newly formed Kent Cycles RC were a force to be reckoned with. This certainly proved to be the case as they walked off with the lion's share of the 2005 awards. They scored a resounding 1-2-3 in the Senior BAR, with Garry Banfield taking the top honour. Joining the team mid-season, Carole Gandy was a comfortable winner of the Ladies BAR. Additionally, the Club recorded individual success in Championships at 25 miles, 50 miles and 12 hour.

Phil Bull successfully defended his title in the Short Distance BAR and in doing showed remarkable consistency. His three qualifying rides were never more than 10 seconds adrift of his 2004 rides. In Phil Saynor, we have a new name engraved on the Veteran's BAR trophy. With twelve successful rides under his belt, he swears that this year will be his last 12 hour event. But I suspect that he may be tempted to come back next year and defend his title.

Two of our major awards went "out of County" this year. Keith Coffey receives the 100 trophy whilst the Roy Enfield Memorial Trophy goes to East Grinstead CC's Brian Phillips. A new name on our Roll of Honour is Gemini BC's Bill Bell who is this year's Hill Climb Champion.

In addition to Carole's achievements, 2005 was a good year for the ladies. Heidi Mason of Hastings and St. Leonards CC is our new Ladies 10 Champion and also picks up 1st lady medal for the Enfield 50. In addition to qualifying for the Ladies BAR again, San Fairy Ann CC's Carolyn Hawkes finished in the 100 at her first attempt, to take the 1st lady award. And finally Suzanne Hilton (Greenwich Triathlon Tri Club) picked up a pair of medals in our Autumn 25.

For further evidence of the popularity of Association events in 2005 you need look no further than our BAR Tables. Each competition saw a remarkable increase in qualifiers over last year, particularly the Short Distance BAR. An impressive 37 riders completed the qualifying distances, almost double last year's total.

Another of this year's success stories was the Kent Time Trial League. With entries floundering in 2004 and the announcement that Alan Hill was stepping down as co-ordinator it was feared the League would collapse entirely. But Carl Bradford and Peter Elms stepped forward and agreed to take it on this year and what an amazing job they made of it. With a total of 33 in the Senior League and 24 in the Veteran's, entries were up by 50% in 2005. With a maximum of 800 points, Garry Banfield topped the Senior table and Reg Smith, also on maximum points, took top honour in the Veteran's table.

So that's about it for the 2005 season. I know that some of you will already be planning your training programme for next year (I certainly am). So I wish you all every success in 2006 and may the Association continue to prosper.
