

RACING REPORT

2006 has been another astounding year for the Association. Entries were up for the 3rd consecutive year and saw us top the 500 mark with a total of 517. And thanks to our near-perfect summer we have seen some astonishing times being recorded. But with the A2070 and A20 being out of action for the best part of the season this has been a nightmare year for event promoters. Both of our 50's had to be switched to alternative courses and in the 48 hours leading up to the 100 start we underwent TWO course changes.

After a gap of six years, Gary Chalkley is back to claim the crown of Kent Champion and his average speed of 24.441 mph is actually faster than his two previous wins (in 1998 and 2000). It's unusual to see a "youngster" featuring prominently in the Veteran's BAR but Gary's 4th place this year shows that he is also a force to be reckoned with in this category. It won't be too many years before he is challenging for top honours in both Championships in the same season.

For further proof of the increase in popularity of KCA events in the last five years you need look no further than the Short Distance BAR. In its inaugural year (2001) we had just 11 qualifiers. This has steadily increased in the intervening years to the impressive 42 riders that qualified this year. Top man this year was Paul Burrow in a record average of 27.650 mph.

After a while you simply run out of adjectives to describe our 21-times Lady Champion. Suffice to say that Carole's qualifying 10 time of 22.57 (in the Kent Vets Championship) was almost a minute quicker than the current KCA record that she set a quarter of a century ago!! How amazing is that?

Shay Giles is another rider that seems to have been around forever. He first won the Senior BAR back in 1984, with repeat performances in 1986 and 1996 and in the latter of those years he became the only rider in our 78 year history to do the double of the Senior and Veteran's titles in the same season. And he's back again this year to take the Veteran's BAR for the 3rd time.

52 years after they last won the trophy; the Southborough and District Wheelers are this year's Team Champions courtesy of Peter Rowe, Neil Quarmby and Mike Eden.

We received affiliations from 5 new clubs this year and it was good to see a couple of them among the award winner's with Mike Hawkins (Larkfield AC) and Mark Wright (DCB Kent) both picking up medals and BAR placings.

Although not a racing matter, this year's Reliability Trial is worthy of a special mention. It's no secret that the San Fairy Ann CC (with a 250-plus membership) has had a stranglehold on the Rootes Challenge Trophy for more years than we care to mention. In an effort to give some of the lesser clubs an optimistic chance of victory organiser Paul Mephram introduced a 100-mile event this year with finishers being allocated 4 points. Medway Velo Club rose to the challenge and came to the 100-mile event mob-handed to provided us with the closest finish that the event has seen. So close was the result that Paul has kept us all in suspense and he will make a special announcement during today's proceedings to disclose the winner.

Finally, a special mention to the League organiser Carl Bradford. He has certainly turned this competition around in the last couple of years and is constantly seeking ways in which to improve it. An entry form for the 2007 season is available today and Carl's report and results can be found elsewhere in these pages.

KENT TIME TRIAL LEAGUE

2006 saw a 10% increase in entrants from last year and has seen new winners of both the Seniors and Vets competitions with perfect 10 out of 10 scores.

Paul Burrows (Kent Cycles RC) was the top League rider in 16 events and 2nd in 5 others, he did have a 6th place as well but is claiming a slow puncture! In all 11 riders gained 100 points for a win. Last year's winner Garry Banfield (Kent Cycles RC) was second in the seniors but along with Gary Chalkley (Kent Cycles RC) and Paul Burrows maintained the Team Prize. Phil Bull is third overall and his VC Elan team picked up third behind the GS Invicta trio of Stephen Castle, Carl Chapman and Adrian Lyons.

The Vets competition also saw 10 riders gaining a League win with 100 points that's nearly half the entrants! New to the League, Alan Brown (West Kent RC) gained 1000 points to claim 1st place with Phil Bull again just missing out in second ahead of John Booty (Wigmore CC). John actually scored either 1st or 2nd in 12 of his last 13 events to just pip Chris Bax (VC Deal), but Chris has made up for that with a 1st place in the Vets Team with Martin Apps (5th overall). 2nd in the Team Prize went to Phil Bull and Les Beautridge of VC Elan with 3rd John Booty and Clin Maisey of Wigmore CC.

Finally all riders who rode the 10 events and a least one of 50 miles or more will get their £5 entry fund repaid. If you like to join again next year then feel free to waive £5 of your winnings in favour of next year's fees!

I would like to thank everyone who assisted with the cries of help for result sheets and I look forward to receiving your entries for 2007.
