Information about the Team Record and Times for all 13 Teams

The Kent Cycles RC team beat the previous record of 5.54.42 by 11 minutes and 11 seconds. The record was held by the San Fairy Ann CC team of Keir Williams, Garry Banfield and Barry Charlton. It had been set in 2004 on the Q50/12 course. There was a double record that year with Gary Chalkley holding it for a short while with Keir and Garry B before Barry came in with a faster time. Kent Cycles RC came to within 11 seconds of breaking it in 2005. Competitors have a considerable challenge if they plan to go for the individual record of 1.47.53 set by Sean Yates, then of Motorola, in 1996 on the old Bethersden course.
