Course Details

Start at edge of track off the B2075, 250 yards south of Hammonds Corner. Proceed to the A259 where left (M) to the Brenzett Little Chef roundabout (M), left to Brookland roundabout (M) (4.580 miles). Turn and retrace to Brenzett Little Chef roundabout (M). Continue on A2070 to Cloverleaf roundabout (M). Take second exit to next roundabout (15.411 miles) (M). Turn and fork left (M) within 300 yards to Cloverleaf roundabout (M). Take the first exit and retrace to Brookland roundabout (M) (26.481 miles). Turn and retrace to Cloverleaf roundabout (M) and next roundabout (M) (37.312 miles). Turn and retrace via Cloverleaf (M) to Brenzett Little Chef roundabout (M). Left on A259 to Finish 30 yards past the sign "P" and "i" 200 yards before Hammonds corner lay-by

Notes

All Riders using formoterol, salbutamol, salmeterol and terbutaline inhalers or insulin for the treatment of a medical condition are required to register an appropriate medical certificate with the General Secretary of British Cycling. They are also advised to obtain a number of copies so that one is available and can be given to the Anti-Doping Inspector to attach one to the sampling forms. The best option is to carry a copy of the certificate with you to events. Failure to register shall not constitute grounds for any appeal against a charge in respect of a breach of the UCI or Cycling Time Trials Anti-Doping Regulations.

Please keep the noise to a minimum to avoid unnecessary disturbance to the local residents.

Riders risk disqualification if they perform U turns in the start and finish areas or use these areas as a public toilet.

Numbers will be at H.Q. (and not the start) and may be exchanged for a drink after. Riders are required to sign on before collecting their number.

ROY ENFIELD

Roy was a member of the all-conquering Medway Wheelers and, accompanied by Ken Joy and Peter Beardsmore, won the team award for the British Best All-Rounder Competition in 1948 and 1949. In 1950 he was travelling across London on his way to a 50 on the Bath Road when he took a seemingly insignificant tumble. Several days after the event he collapsed and subsequently died from a ruptured spleen at 30 years of age, just six weeks after his marriage.

Former Wheeler Ron Ash, and Roy's erstwhile tandem partner, says of him: "He was such a popular character and had a wicked sense of humour. People knew him from all over the country. It was a tragedy that he lost his life at such a young age".

This event has been held in his memory for the past 56 years.
