Course Details

Q25/20 Harrietsham - Ashford - Leeds Castle - Harrietsham

Start at the 18th kerb joint east of Marley entrance to Dickley Corner, Harrietsham (TQ 885528). Proceed to join A20 (M) eastwards, via Charing Roundabout (M) to turn at Orchard Heights Roundabout (M), Ashford (9.218 miles). Retrace A20 via Charing (M) to turn at Leeds Roundabout (M) (22.319 miles). Retrace A20 to finish 10 metres past MOT sign, just short of Willow Close, Harrietsham. (TQ 865525).

IMPORTANT COURSE NOTES FOR ALL EVENTS ON HARRIETSHAM

Strictly **NO PARKING** in Marley's private car park.

No parking in Dickley Lane except for timekeepers.

Riders should not arrive at the start more than 5 minutes before their allotted start.

Riders must not turn or congregate in the driveway to the Marley works.

Riders proven to be associated with any car parking or turning in this vicinity will be disqualified from the event.

A member of the South East District Council Committee will be at the start to ensure that these instructions are obeyed.

Event Headquarters

Harrietsham Village Hall

Travelling from the direction of Maidstone on the A20, turn left just prior to the railway bridge. The HQ is then about a quarter of a mile on the right.

Start location

From the HQ, retrace to the A20 and turn left. Dickley Lane is the 1st left at the top of Harrietsham hill.

Distance from HQ to the start is approximately 1 mile.

Notes

National CTT requirements

All competitors using inhalers or insulin for the treatment of a medical condition are required to register an appropriate medical certificate with the General Secretary of British Cycling.

Junior competitors must wear a protective helmet that complies with the requirements of CTT Regulation 15.

Numbers will be at the HQ and may be exchanged for a drink after. Riders are required to sign on before collecting their number.

Please keep the noise to a minimum to avoid unnecessary disturbance to the local residents.

Riders risk disqualification if they perform U turns in the start and finish areas or use these areas as a public toilet.

Local requirements

Please keep the noise to a minimum to avoid unnecessary disturbance to the local residents.

Please do not distract the start or finish timekeepers.

Strictly no warming up on the course after the event has started.
