He was also 3<sup>rd</sup> in last years National '50' with a 1-46 and led the winning team. Also in that team and appearing in this event was Graeme Stirzaker no mean performer with a 51 minute pb. It was indeed an honour to welcome such riders for the first time to this event. Pete Tadros was going for a hat trick of wins denied to him last year by Paul Mill. He did break his own event record and achieved a hat trick. But not the one he would have liked. He now has three 2<sup>nd</sup> places to go with his two wins in this event.

Ben produced arguably the quickest '25' ever in Kent, if we discount the times done in the 1970's on the drag strip of the A2 at Gravesend. A new course and event record that should indicate to other top riders that Chilham is capable of producing the goods. As you have seen Wigmore CC produced the money. Ben, £190 cannot be bad for 52 minutes work. I do hope that you will be back.

My congratulations go to all of the other prize winners and to those of you who I feel sure found a pb. The rain stopped shortly before the start and it turned out to be quite a good morning. Well, that is how it appeared to me driving around the course. From the amount of punctures suffered, I guess that the rain in the preceeding week had washed a lot of grit into the road. Most unfortunate.

The big hard luck story of the morning befell Jim Boyle (Boston Wheelers). For 12 months I had been badgering Jim, a near neighbour of mine in Lincolnshire and a rapid young vet, to come down to Kent and see what we had to offer. Barely on the start line and a blow out. A 400 mile round trip and a Travel Lodge and it all came to nothing. I was really upset for you, about that Jim. 2008?

Raymond Firth also had his share of bad luck. He took a tumble and wrote off his bike. I hope Raymond that you have recovered from your bruises.

I once again was proud to promote this event in memory of Bill Philbrook a late President of the Wigmore CC. Pleased too that his widow Mary could once again attend. Also that his son Robert was able to make the trip from his Doncaster home to present the prizes.

My thanks to all who entered. I do hope to see you all again next year. Maybe even sooner as the Wigmore CC Classic 32<sup>nd</sup> Open Hill Climb (inc the Kent CA Champ) is on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> October at Hollingbourne. Another super prize list of over £600.

You want to know about another event? £700 is up for grabs in the initial Nev Crane Memorial '25' in Lincolnshire on July 15<sup>th</sup>. A sensible 8 am start. I am promoting this event for the Sleaford Wheelers and it will be run on similar lines to the Wigmore event.
